  - Fits easily with aims of NACRE



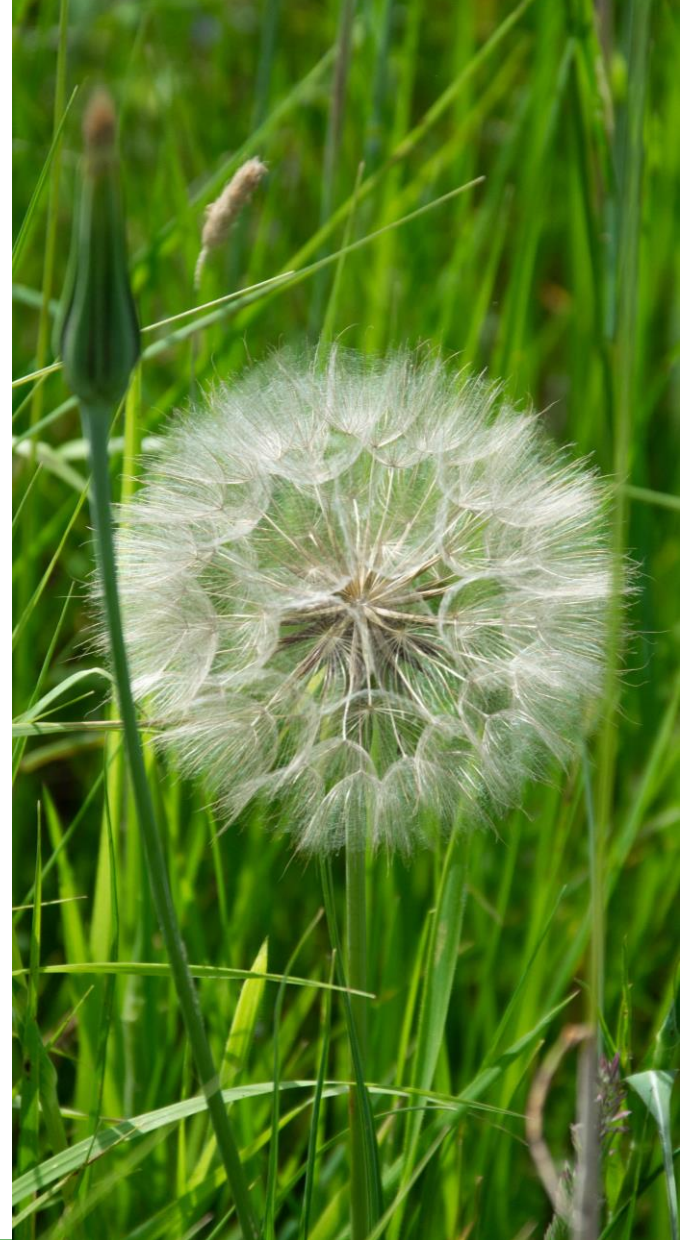


# Wedding Business
